### Know Your Account Number!

With electronic transactions on the rise, thanks to the ease of technology and the internet. **It is extremely important for you to KNOW and understand your account number.**

Using the wrong number when setting up a direct deposit or electronic debits, could result in your funds being returned/rejected. This happens more than you might think, hence this article!

For security purposes, in eBranch and Mobile Money you only see a portion of your account number, along with a suffix after an equals sign. For example, \*9999=00 is a primary savings account and a primary checking account shows as \*9999=10. On statements you would see 99999 - Acct 00 for a primary savings account and 99999 - Acct 10 for a checking account.

NONE of those shown above are your ACTUAL account number and should NEVER be used. Please note, your savings account number and checking account number are NOT the same. **Your FULL account number will NOT include any symbols, dashes or asterisks. When in doubt, call us!**

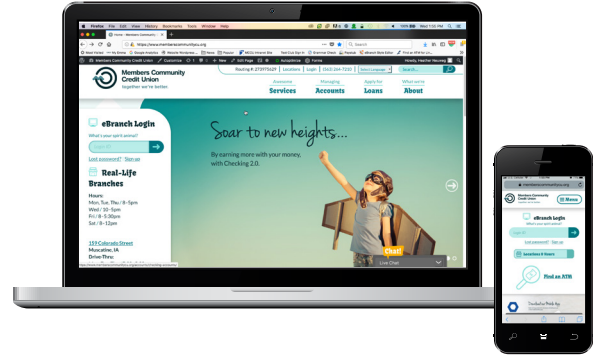
