The Many Ways to Access Your Accounts

Do you know ALL the ways MCCU members can access their accounts both remotely and in-person? If not, grab your phone, tablet or computer, and refresh yourself on the multiple ways we can meet your needs.

Online and Mobile Banking are your primary on-the-go services allowing you to bank from virtually anywhere, anytime. Check balances, pending transactions, apply for a loan, make a mobile deposit using the app and MORE. These tools put your MCCU account at your fingertips when it's most convenient to you.

Register your mobile phone number in eBranch by doing the following. Click **Self Service > Preferences** and select **Registered Mobile Alert Number*** and enter/update your cell number, finish by clicking the **Update Mobile** button. Now you can text the list of commands on the right to 319-519-4169 for instant access to your accounts.

We also welcome in-person visits, stop by your preferred branch during the week between 9am and 5pm or Saturday 9am to noon. If utilizing our drive-thrus is more your jam, swing by anytime 8am to 5:30pm, Monday through Thursday or til 6pm on Fridays. Otherwise our drive-thrus are open Saturday 8am to Noon, too!

Even just \$10 a week will leave you with OVER \$300 when funds are automatically transferred to your primary savings account on November 1st!

Maybe you just need a little breathing room and skipping a loan payment will help you get back on track. Members with a minimum of six monthly payments made, with accounts in good standing are eligible to skip up to 2 loan payments per calendar year, just NOT consecutively in a row.
